What is Friends of the Shelter?

Friends of the Shelter, a Los Alamos humane organization, is improving the quality of life for unwanted pets and finding homes for homeless animals. Our goal is to have no homeless pets in the county by 2012 and we work closely with the county-run animal shelter, with local veterinarians, and with other humane societies to achieve this goal.

The program has four major components:

1. shelter program - volunteers visit the shelter daily to exercise, groom, and socialize the animals to make them more adoptable;
2. active adoption program - animals are advertised and people are screened so that animals are placed into appropriate homes;
3. health program - helps pay for medical expenses and spay/neuter operations for pets whose owners who cannot afford the cost and for abandoned animals that would otherwise not be treated; and
4. education program - promotes responsible pet ownership, including the benefits and importance of spaying/neutering pets.

Photo Entry Rules

Photo Eligibility: Photos must be of --

- ➔ pets adopted from the Los Alamos Animal Shelter
OR
- ➔ pets adopted from other shelters (or otherwise rescued) whose owners live or work in Los Alamos County.

Quantity Limits: We cannot accept more than 3 photos per household. Use a separate entry form for each photo submitted.

Submission Formats: Photos should be submitted as Black & White or color, 3x5 or 4x6 prints. Digital photos will also be accepted in JPEG, GIF, PNG, TIFF or PICT formats, and should be at least 300 dpi or more for clear quality.
